

# Day 1: USA/Beijing, China

Depart for Beijing, capital of China.

#### Day 2: Arriva in Beijing

Arrive in Beijing. Stay in your deluxe hotel.





## Day 3: Beijing (B/SL)

Today's group tour starts with the **Tiananmen Square** and followed by the Forbidden City (UNESCO Heritage Site), in which 24 emperors lived from 1421 to 1911AD. Special Lunch with Peking **Duck** (Beijing delicacy).

# Day 4: Beijing (B/L)

Today's highlight is the **Great Wall** (UNESCO Heritage Site), the greatest project in ancient China.

# Day 5: Beijing (B/L)

Start with the Temple of Heaven (UNESCO Heritage Site), a landmark of China built in 1420 AD. This was the site that emperors of Ming and Qing Dynasties worshiped heaven and pray for abundant harvest. Now it is open to the public where you will also see many local people doing various morning exercises. Then we will enjoy the **Hutong Tour** by rickshaw, which will bring you to the old residential quarters, where you will visit houses of traditional architecture. Lunch in a local restaurant.

### Day 6: Beijing / Xi'an (B)

Depart for Xi'an - ancient capital of China. Transfer to your deluxe hotel. Free at leisure for the rest of the day.

### Day 7: Xi'an (B/L/SD)

Today's tour starts with the ancient **City Wall** built in Ming Dynasty (1368 – 1644 AD). Then we'll visit the **Small Wild Goose Pagoda** built in Tang Dynasty (618 – 907 AD) and **Xi'an Museum.** Enjoy the fantastic **Tang Dynasty dinner Show**.

### Day 8: Xi'an (B/L)

Today's highlights are the **Terra-cotta Warriors and Horses** (UNESCO Heritage Site) including **Bronze Chariot.** At lunch you will see the demonstration of **local hand-made noodles**.

# Day 9: Xi'an / Lhasa (B/D)

Flight to Lhasa, capital of Tibet. En route to the hotel, enjoy the unique scenery of Tibet. Stay in your superior first class hotel located in the center of Lhasa. Have a good rest in the remainder of the day and get used to the high altitude.

## Day 10: Lhasa (B/L)

Today's highlight is the **Potala Palace** (UNESCO Heritage Site), the former Winter Palace of Dalai Lama, which is famed as a "bright pearl" on the "Roof of the World". Then the **Sera Monastery**, where you will meet many Tibetan monks practicing debating.

### Day 11: Lhasa (B/L/D)

Visit the **Jokhang Temple**, one of Buddhism's holiest shrines. Here you will see Tibetan prayers from various areas. It is a memorable experience to take a stroll in the famous **Barkhor Street** (around the Jokhang Temple) where there are crowds of Tibetan pilgrims.

### Day 12: Lhasa/Chongqing (B)

flight

Fly to Chongqing, an important Yangtze River port city. Transfer to your centrally located deluxe hotel. Free at leisure for the rest of the day.

## Day 13: Chongqing/Yangtze River Cruise (B/D)

City tour including **Giant Pandas**, **City Square** and **Downtown** (where restaurants for both local and Western food are available for lunch on your own). Optional foot massage. Board your deluxe cruise ship after group dinner.

## Day 14: Yangtze River Cruise (B/L/SD)

Shore excursion to **Jade Emperor** (temples) in Fengdu, which is related with Buddhism and Taoism. **Captain's welcome reception** followed by **Chinese cultural show** and **welcome dinner**.

# Day 15: Yangtze River Cruise (B/L/SD)

Sail through **Qutang Gorge** and **Wu Gorge**. Today's excursion is to take a smaller boat through the beautiful **Goddess Stream**, one of the tributaries of the Yangtze River. Then the cruise enters **Xiling Gorge**. Enjoy **Captain's farewell dinner** this evening.

## Day 16: Yichang/Shanghai (B)

Disembark and fly to Shanghai (visit the **Three Gorges Dam** if time permits). Transfer to your deluxe hotel. The rest of the day is free at leisure.







### Day 17: Shanghai (B/D)

Start the tour with the renowned **Shanghai Museum** with priceless collections of jade, bronzes, ceramics, calligraphy and Chinese furniture. Then the **Old Town of Shanghai** followed by the **Bund**, from where you can enjoy the view of both traditional and modern Shanghai (varieties of restaurants and food venders are available in the Old Town for lunch on your own). Exciting **Acrobatic Show** after group dinner in a local restaurant.

### Day 18: Shanghai/Suzhou/Shanghai (B/L)

Enjoy a day-tour to Suzhou, which is well-known as "Venice in the East", "City of Gardens" and "Capital of Silk". The tour in Suzhou includes the **Garden of Master Fishnet** (UNESCO Heritage Site), **Silk Spinning Factory** and **boat trip on ancient man-made Grand Canal**. Return to Shanghai in late afternoon.
